

UN Secretary-General Kofi Annan has decided to appoint an Advisory Committee on Genocide Prevention to provide guidance and support to the work of the Secretary-Generals Special Adviser on the Prevention of Genocide and contribute to the broader efforts of the United Nations to prevent genocide.

**Romo Dallaire** of Canada, Canadian Senator and former Force Commander of the United Nations Assistance Mission for Rwanda;

**Gareth Evans** of Australia, President, International Crisis Group and former Minister for Foreign Affairs of Australia;

**Roberto Garretn** of Chile, former representative of the High Commissioner for Human Rights for Latin America and the Caribbean and former Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in the Democratic Republic of the Congo;

**Sadako Ogata** of Japan, co-Chair of the Commission on Human Security and former High Commissioner for Refugees; and

**Archbishop Desmond Tutu** of South Africa, winner of the Nobel Peace Prize and former Chairman of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of South Africa.
